# VOTER Q&A

• **Do I have to bring my registration card to the polling place on Election Day?** You are not required to bring your Registration Card to the polling place on Election Day. However, you may be asked to present identification. Also, your polling place and voting districts are listed on the card.

• **What if I need assistance at the polls?** A voter with a disability or inability to read English sufficiently to mark a ballot may receive assistance.

A person of the voter's choice or two Election Judges may provide assistance after taking an oath and completing an Affidavit. An agent of the voter's employer or union may not provide assistance.

• **Does my ballot list the correct candidates and public questions?** If you are not sure you have the correct ballot, ask the Election Judge. You should be sure before you cast your ballot. Once a ballot is in the ballot box you cannot receive another ballot.

• **Will a write-in vote count?** Only write-in votes for a person who has filed a "Declaration of Intent To Be a Write-in Candidate" with the Madison County Clerk are considered valid and counted. To cast a write-in for a declared write-in candidate, write the name on the line provided under the appropriate office and darken the corresponding oval.

• **How do I find my polling place?** You may refer to your Registration Card, visit the polling place finder at [www.madisonvotes.com](http://www.madisonvotes.com) or call **692-6290**.

• **What if I make a mistake when marking my ballot?** If you make a mistake, do not attempt to erase or cross out the mistake. Simply turn in the old ballot to the Election Judge and receive a new ballot.

Voters will also get a second chance to mark a new ballot if an error, such as an over vote, is detected by the tabulator. An over vote is when a vote is cast for too many candidates in a race.

• **How do I find out the election results on Election Night?** For unofficial results from Madison County, visit our web site at [www.madisonvotes.com](http://www.madisonvotes.com).

The County Clerk's office also provides results to the Granite City Public Access Channel 993 and Madison Telco Channel 13. Check your listings for the specific channel in your area.

• **Vote by Mail.** Download application at [www.madisonvotes.com](http://www.madisonvotes.com), or e-mail us at [absentee@co.madison.il.us](mailto:absentee@co.madison.il.us), or call us at **(618) 692-6290**. The Madison County Clerk's Office will need your **name, residence address, mailing address and date of birth** at the time of request. After we receive your application, a packet with the ballot, instructions, certificate envelope and a return mailing envelope will be mailed to you. All mail-in ballots postmarked on or before March 15, 2016 will be counted.

### Are You A Registered Voter?

#### You can register to vote if you are:

- A United States citizen
- A resident of your Madison County precinct address for at least 30 days immediately prior to an election.

*Two forms of identification are required to register. At least one of the two forms must show your name and current address.*

#### You can register to vote:

- Register in-person at the County Clerk's office - 157 North Main Street, Edwardsville, IL 62025. **618-692-6290**, at any Early Voting site, or at your polling place election day.

#### Who is qualified to vote by mail?

If you are registered to vote in Madison County, you are eligible to cast a ballot by mail.

#### In addition, the following unregistered voters are eligible to vote by mail:

- Members of the Armed Forces or Merchant Marine and their spouses and dependents whether serving in the United States or abroad whose permanent residence is in Madison County;
- U.S. citizens and their spouses or dependents, whose permanent residence is in Madison County but who will be temporarily residing abroad on election day;
- U.S. citizens (*not their spouses or dependents*) who maintained a residence in Madison County immediately prior to their departure from the United States.

#### The Vote by Mail Balloting Process

1. Verify voter registration
2. Get an application to vote by mail
3. Fill out and send application to vote by mail to the County Clerk's office
4. Receive vote by mail ballot packet
5. Return vote by mail ballot packet

*\*Vote by mail ballot packets must be complete. They are often returned because the application is not signed or the application is not included or no signature on affidavit or ballot not in official affidavit envelope.*

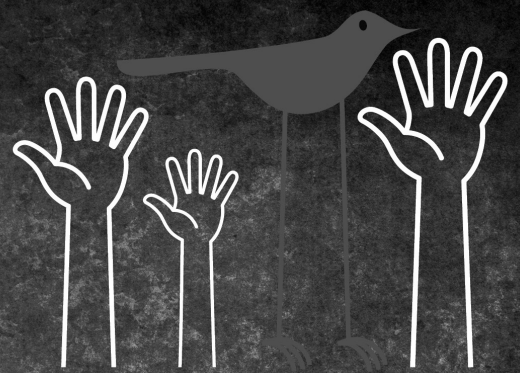
